

- S. GOLD CHARM** The color can vary from light yellow to a full gold, depending on temperature. Try to keep above 10C.
- S. CORAL CASCADE** Brilliant rose coral flower.
- S. MALIBOU** Large coral red, edged in a line of red.
- S. MADISTO** Large double pink flowers.
- S. MISS SHIMANO** Delicate shades of white & lavender with a thin edge of darker lavender.
- S. ROCKET** Two-toned blooms of deep purple and white throat, which extends out to sepals.
- S. TWILIGHT TANGERINE** Bright orange flowers with veining extending down into the white throat. Wide open blooms.
- S. WHITE XMAS** Very strong, glossy leaves. Many translucent white blooms, sometimes tinted pink. Blooms early December.
- SOLANUM JASMINOIDES** (Potato Vine) Star shaped white blooms of this floriferous vine are accented by a cluster of yellow stamens.
- STAPELIA** (Carrion flower) Succulent with fleshy angular upright stems, smelly flowers
- STEPHANOTIS FLORIBUNDA** (Madagascar Jasmine) Wiry twiner with leathery leaves and very fragrant white flowers.
- STREPTOCARPELLA GOOD HOPE** Sky blue flowers over velvety green foliage.
- STREPTOCARPUS ASSORTED** Blooms in assorted shades of pink, violet, blue, lilac, lavender.
- SUCCULENTS**, assorted. Small varieties.
- TETRADENIA RIPARIA** (Nutmeg Bush) Woody-stemmed shrub with musky leaves, creamy flowers.
- TIBOUCHINA URVILLEANA** (Glory Bush) Free branching tree-like shrub with fresh green hair covered leaves. Large 3" royal purple blooms.
- TIBOUCHINA URVILLEANA EDWARDSII** Larger flowers and a more compact habit than above.
- TILLANDSIA**, assorted. Bromeliads and air plants.
- TRACHELOSPERMUM ASIATICUM** (Asiatic Jasmine) A compact vine with tidy dark green leaves adorned with cinnamon scented yellow blooms.
- TRADESCANTIA SPATHACEA** (Moses in a Cradle) Rosette of green lance-shaped leaves, purple below.

ORCHIDS We offer a few varieties expected to do well in the same conditions as African violets.

PHALAEOPSIS and DORITAENOPSIS

The Orchid most likely to succeed in your home is the "Moth Orchid" with large blooms in white, cream, pink, or mauve. Once mature they will generally bloom at least twice a year and the blooms will last a long time. Water about twice a week in the summer, once a week in the winter. Regular fertilizing is necessary.

DENDROBIUM

These can be grown side by side with the Phalaenopsis above. The flowers are smaller but more numerous. Assorted colors — Pink, Purple or 2-tone.

PAPHIOPEDILUM

These "Lady Slipper" orchids have mottled green leaves and large green or burgundy blooms lasting up to 6 weeks. They are warm growing and prefer low to medium light levels. Water and fertilize as for Phalaenopsis.

ONCIDIUM

The "Dancing Ladies" produce a cloud of flowers in yellow with red, burgundy, or brown markings. Some varieties are fragrant. They prefer warm days and bright morning light. Do not overwater.

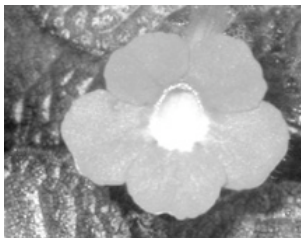
ZYGOPETALUM

Sweetly scented with 7-8 flowers in green, purple, or burgundy, that last 4-8 weeks. Late winter to spring bloomer, mature plants can bloom twice a year. Low to medium light, cool nights to induce blooming. Keep moist.

AFRICAN VIOLETS

Leaves \$1.25 each, plants \$3.50 each.

These plants have been selected from among 100s of varieties introduced in the past few years. They will provide interesting color combinations in both blooms and leaves. We include some yellows — they are not solid yellow, but feature splashes or shadings of yellow. For all varieties, color varies with growing conditions. Varieties new to the catalogue this year are shown with .

- APACHE CHARMER** Pansy-shaped flowers on foliage accented in pink and white on wavy dk green.
- ARAPAHOE** Semi-double stars of brilliant red, pointed bright green leaves. Vigorous grower.
- BUCKEYE BOUQUET** Semi-double to double ruffled blooms in lavender-pink with raspberry and purple fantasy, variable raspberry edge. Leaves variegated green and cream.
- BUCKEYE CHERRY FRECKLES** Semi-double pansy pink blooms with red fantasy. Variegated foliage in green, white, and cream.
- CANADIAN BOREAL** Semi-double purple pansies with coral puffs, white edge. Dark green foliage.
- CHANTILLY LACE** Double white stars with thin red edge. Ruffled foliage in green and white.
- CHIFFON PRINCE** Large semi-double blooms in light lavender tipped in royal purple. Dark olive foliage with tan variegation.
- CHRISTINE** Semi-double to double pink two-tone pansies with darker eye, white-green ruffled edge. Variegated green, pink and white wavy leaves.
- DEEP SKY** Single dark blue pansies with dark pink and white markings, over dark green foliage.
- DESIGNER STAR** Semi-double plum stars with pink fantasy, white edge. Dark green quilted leaves.
- DUMPLIN'** Double pink two-tone blooms over plain green, quilted leaves.
- FICKLE FLIRT** Semi-double pink stars with blue fantasy, white edge. Plain green, quilted foliage.
- FREDETTE'S RISEN STAR** Pink semi-double stars with a sparkling of raspberry glitter over tailored green and cream variegated foliage.
- GRANGER'S WONDERLAND** Semi-double light blue fringed blooms cap plain green ruffled leaves.
- GREAT EXPECTATIONS** Double lavender fantasy blooms with white edge. Plain green foliage.
- NATALIE PINEAULT** White ruffled edges on double wine blossoms. Deep green foliage with red reverse.
- ODE TO BEAUTY** Beautiful semi-double coral stars, banded in raspberry and sporting a wide white edge. Dark green quilted leaves.
- PAGAN IMAGE** Double stars of peachy-pink with glowing centers and fringed edges. Dark green and cream foliage, slightly ruffled.

- ❑ **PARADISE LOST** Double lavender stars with white frilled edge. Medium green, ruffled leaves.
- ❑ **PLENTY OF PEPPER** Large semi-double stars up to 2 1/4" across, in glowing Cajun-red. Medium green glossy foliage that is tailored and pointed.
- ✿ **POWDER KEG** Semi-double dark red stars with white edge. Dark green quilted leaves with red reverse.
- ✿ **PUEBLO** Large semi-double stars in deep and bright coral. Dark green tailored foliage.
- ❑ **RAINBOW'S NEW HORIZONS** Semi-double light-medium blue stars with white and pink fantasy. Tommie Lou variegated, quilted foliage.
- ✿ **RODEO COUNTRY** Semi-double to double medium blue blooms. Dark green leaves with red reverse.
- ❑ **SOMETHING SPECIAL** Semi-double dark blue-purple blooms dance over plain green foliage.
- ❑ **SPLENDIFEROUS** Single pale pink stars with red eye, white fringed edge. Dk green quilted leaves.
- ❑ **STARLETTE** Semi-double pink stars banded in red, edged in white and green. Dark green quilted foliage.
- ❑ **SUN SIZZLE** Single to semi-double fuchsia stars with white wavy edge. Med green quilted leaves.
- ❑ **SWELL ELEGANT** Single dark red-fuchsia frilled pansies with white markings. Variegated dark green, pink and bronze, glossy leaves.
- ✿ **SWIFTY THRILLER** Fringed double lavender two-toned blooms. Green, cream, and pink ruffled leaves.
- ❑ **TOMAHAWK** Vibrant semi-double Red blooms over dark Green foliage on a symmetrical plant.
- ❑ **VENUS BUTTERFLY** Semi-double large watermelon red two tone star, up to 3" across. Dark green pointed, red-backed foliage.
- ❑ **VICTORIAN VELVET** Very large deep magenta semi-double stars with frilly edging accented in pink. Red reverse on medium green leaves.
- ❑ **WHITE LACE** Ruffled white double flowers mottled with purplish-blue. Ruffled medium green foliage.
- ❑ **WINDY DAY** Semi-double blue stars with white-green ruffled edge. Dark green red-backed leaves.

- ❑ **ACA'S CORAL LAGOON** Ruffled stars of semi-double coral. Dark green scalloped foliage.
- ❑ **ACA'S RED EMBER** Semi-double red pansy blooms over green and white variegated foliage.
- ❑ **ANNABELLE** Double pink two-tone shaded blooms over dark green leaves with red backs.
- ✿ **ALAMO FROST** Semi-double white blooms with green edge over medium green leaves.
- ✿ **ALAMO GOLDRUSH** Double gold blooms with pink shading over variegated green and white leaves.
- ✿ **ALAMO RAINBOW** White and lavender semi-double blossoms with blue and pink fantasy edges, medium green plain leaves.

PASSIFLORA (Passion Flower) *Vining plants that can be twined on a trellis or planted in a basket.*

- ✿ **P. AMETHYST** Twining stems with spectacular fragrant purple-mauve blooms, three-lobed leaves.
 - ✿ **P. CAERULEA** (Blue passion flower). Fast-growing, semi-evergreen climber with blue and white flowers, followed by edible, but not especially delicious, egg-shaped yellow fruit. Frost hardy in mild areas.
 - ❑ **P. EDULIS** Edible 3" fruit in your sunroom! White blooms with lavender corolla. Delicious fruit juice.
 - ✿ **P. MOLLISSIMA** Large pink flowers, yellow fruit. Leaves three-lobed, softly-downy underneath..
 - ❑ **P. VITIFOLIA** Profuse red blooms, petals somewhat reflexed. Grape-like thick leaves.
 - ✿ **PELARGONIUM VANCOUVER CENTENNIAL** A dwarf plant with golden maple-like leaves with bronze central splotches, and bright orange-red flowers.
 - ❑ **PENTAS LANCEOLATA** (Egyptian Star Cluster) An everblooming plant with umbels of red or pink flowers. Bright green leaves. Good light.
 - ❑ **PEPEROMIA LITTLE FANTASY** Small heart shaped wrinkled leaves, rat-tail flower spikes.
 - ❑ **PEPEROMIA PEPPER FACE** Large spoon shaped leaves with white-cream variegation.
 - ❑ **PEPEROMIA GUAVEOLENS** Banana like leaves, burgundy on bottom and green on top.
- PHYGELIUS** *Cape Fuchsia Fairly hardy herbaceous perennials from South Africa with hanging fuchsia-like blooms. Good patio plants to attract hummingbirds, can be over-wintered outdoors in mild areas.*
- ❑ **PHYGELIUS AFRICAN QUEEN** Coral pink blooms.
 - ❑ **PHYGELIUS MOONRAKER** Creamy yellow flowers.
 - ❑ **PHYGELIUS DEVIL'S TEARS** Scarlet flowers with yellow throat.
 - ❑ **PLECTRANTHUS AMBOINICUS** (Cuban Oregano) Thick fuzzy green leaves with oregano fragrance.
 - ❑ **PLECTRANTHUS VARIEGATA** (Swedish Ivy) Fast growing trailing plant with hairy green leaves with white scalloped edges. Leaves release a pleasant herbal aroma when touched.
 - ❑ **PLECTRANTHUS NICO** A spreading or trailing foliage plant with very dark shiny leaves that are burgundy on the reverse.
 - ❑ **PLUMBAGO AURICULATA** (Cape Leadwort) Attractive plant with true blue, Phlox-like flowers in profusion from spring to winter. A rare color.
 - ❑ **PODOCARPUS MACROPHYLLUS** (Buddhist Pine) Upright stems with narrow glossy leaves. Keep in a cool spot.
 - ❑ **PORTULACARIA AFRA VARIEGATA** (Rainbow Bush) Lovely succulent with red brown stems and pretty leaves, margined in creamy white and a thin carmine red edging.
 - ❑ **PSIDIUM GUAJAVA** (Guava) Leathery green leaves

on spreading branches. A nice shrubby foliage plant.

- ❑ **RADERMACHERA SINICA** (China Doll) An excellent foliage plant with glossy green leaves and many branches. Likes moist, fertile soil.
- RHIPHALIDOPSIS (Easter Cacti)** *These resemble Christmas Cacti but the branch segments are more gently rounded. They normally bloom in April and May, and sometimes again in the fall. Culture is similar to Christmas Cacti but they do not need to be "timed".*
- ❑ **R. ANDROMEDA** Deep lavender pink flowers. A very heavy bloomer and a vigorous grower.
 - ❑ **R. CAPRICE** Pink star-shaped blooms, with a darker midstripe down each petal.
 - ❑ **R. GAERTNERI GIANT** Flaring flowers of brilliant orange red often hiding the leaves completely. Largest blooms of any Easter Cactus to date.
 - ❑ **R. ROSEA** A tiny jointed plant that produces clouds of light Pink flowers. Almost a miniature. It needs to be moist but too much water is fatal.
 - ❑ **R. SUTTERS GOLD** Large blooms of Gold Orange-Red, and just a fleck of Red. Even, compact grower.
 - ✿ **RHIPHALIS CEREUSCULA (Rice cactus)** Thin green segmented stems with cream flowers. Segments break easily into rice like fragments.
 - ❑ **RHODOCHITON ATROSANGUINEUM** (Purple Bells) A climber from Mexico with heart-shaped leaves and long-lasting, dark purple bells.
 - ❑ **RUPELLIA MAKOYANA** (Monkey Plant) Violet tinged olive green leaves with silvery veins on top, purple lower surface. Fuchsia trumpet flowers 3 cm long.
 - ❑ **SANSEVIERIA TRIFASCIATA LAURENTI** (Mother-in-Law's Tongue). Sword-like leaves with golden edges, a very tough plant.
 - ❑ **SAXIFRAGA STOLONIFERA** (Strawberry Geranium) Hanging basket plant producing smaller plantlets on runners. White flowers. Bright light, not too wet.
 - ❑ **SCHEFFLERA ARBORICOLA** (Hawaiian Dwarf Schefflera) Shrubby, needs bright light and moist.
- SCHLUMBERGERA** (Christmas Cacti) They will normally bloom the same time each year but you can experiment in 2 ways. Temperature: keep nights 12-15C to set buds. Light: more than 12 hours of darkness at about 15C will initiate flower buds. Give bright filtered light and let dry out somewhat between waterings.
- ❑ **S. ASPEN** Snow white bloom with serrated edges. Keep temp above 10C or blooms will be pinkish.
 - ❑ **S. BRIDGESII** The original Christmas Cactus. Small glossy green leaves on an arching stem. Carmine red and purple blooms.
 - ❑ **S. BRISTOL QUEEN** Dramatic 2" bloom. White centers and fuchsia petal edges and tips.
 - ❑ **S. CHRISTMAS FLAME** Silky white inner petals, outer petals golden yellow. Keep above 10C.
 - ❑ **S. CHRISTMAS MAGIC II** Very big flowers here. Purplish red.

JASMINUM (Jasmine) Sweetly scented blooms. At least some of these varieties are always in bloom. Grow in good light but not full summer sun. Keep evenly moist.

- ✿ **J. FIONA SUNRISE** Deciduous climber with brilliant yellow leaves and white fragrant flowers in summer.
- ✿ **J. FLORIDUM** Compact species with small everblooming flowers. Small green leaves.
- ☐ **J. HUMILE REVOLUTUM** Yellow blooms and a spicy carnation fragrance.
- ☐ **J. NUDIFLORUM** Nearly erect plant with glossy green leaves. Yellow blooms in early spring.
- ☐ **J. OFFICINALE** Poet's Jasmine. Fragrant starry white flowers on twining stems from spring to fall.
- ☐ **J. OFFICINALE GRANDIFLORUM** (French Perfume Jasmine) Double white flowers on twining stems from spring to fall. Strong scent.
- ☐ **J. POLYANTHUM** (Winter Jasmine) Blooms early in the year with deliciously scented masses of white flowers. Compact vine.
- ☐ **J. SAMBAC** (Maid of Orleans) Bushy growing. Single fragrant blooms used for scenting tea.
- ☐ **J. X STEPHANSE** Evergreen hybrid between *J. beesianum* and *officinale*. Climbing vine with slender shoots. Fragrant pink flowers, summer.
- ☐ **J. TORTUOSUM** A South African vining Jasmine with good vigor and a fruity fragrance from its pure white star-shaped flowers.
- ✿ **KOHLERIA CLOWN PRINCE** Fuzzy leaved gesneriad with rose blooms sporting darker rose dots on face and throat. Fairly compact. Keep moist.
- ☐ **LANTANA CAMARA** (Yellow Sage) A West Indies shrub with bristly green leaves. Flowers open pink and yellow, maturing to red-orange.
- ☐ **LANTANA MONTEVIDENSIS** (Weeping Lantana) Everblooming lavender flowers with a trailing habit suitable for baskets.
- ☐ **LEDEBOURIA SOCIALIS** (Silver squill). Tiny bulbs form straplike leaves with leopard spots and small spikes of Muscari-like flowers.
- ✿ **LONICERA NITIDA BAGGESEN'S GOLD** (Gold box honeysuckle). Bushy evergreen shrub with golden leaves in bright light, great for container topiary.
- ✿ **L. NITIDA LEMON BEAUTY** (Box Honeysuckle) Upright evergreen branches with narrow green leaves, each with a golden border.
- ☐ **MANDEVILLA SANDERI** (Dipladenia) Light pink flowers, yellow throat to 3". Shiny green leaves. Everblooming. Pinch to keep in shape.
- ☐ **MARANTA LEUCONEURA** (Prayer Plant). Oblong green leaves with brown blotches.
- ☐ **MARANTA ERYTHRONEURA** (Herringbone Plant). Similar to the prayer plant, but with bold red veins.
- ✿ **MELALEUCA ALTERNIFOLIA** (Tea Tree) Shrub with citrus scented leaves and white bottlebrush flowers.

- ☐ **MIKENIA TERNATA** (Plush vine) Fast-growing trailer with small purplish hairy leaves. Keep moist, likes bright light.
- ✿ **MIMOSA PUDICA** (Sensitive Plant) Feathery leaves that fold up when touched, pink ball flowers.
- ☐ **MONSTERA DELICIOSA** (Swiss Cheese plant), Mexican breadfruit. Large glossy split leaves and aerial roots, needs support to grow large.
- ☐ **MUEHLENBECKIA COMPLEXA** (Maidenhair vine) Tiny leaves and black stems. Bears small, white edible fruit.
- ☐ **MURRAYA EXOTICA** (Orange Jasmine) A compact plant, but can be constantly in bloom and covered with small red berries. Orange scented white flowers.
- ✿ **NANDINA DOMESTICA** (Heavenly bamboo) An upright evergreen shrub with compound leaves in metallic green, turning red in winter. Cane like stems. *Limited quantities.*

NEMATANTHUS *Primarily hanging basket plants but can be grown in pots. Orange, red & yellow pouch-shaped blooms. They need a bit more light than violets.*

- ☐ **N. CHRISTMAS HOLLY** Bright shiny green leaves. Brilliant red blooms.
 - ☐ **N. DUGNY** Large yellow flowers with red stripes. Dark glossy foliage shaded deep red. (*limited #*)
 - ✿ **N. DIBLEY'S GOLD** Dark Green leaves variegated with Gold. Orange flowers.
 - ✿ **N. FRECKLES** Orange flowers with maroon spots where petals join. Glossy green leaves.
 - ☐ **N. STOPLIGHT** Leather-like green leaves, with red undersides. Small red blooms in pedicels.
 - ☐ **N. TROPICANA** Dark green shiny leaves. Large gold blooms, striped in garnet red.
- NERIUM OLEANDER (Rose Bay)** *Evergreen shrubs that reach 3 or 4 feet if potted in tubs, so make ideal patio plants. Can also be pruned back for houseplants. Long narrow leaves, upward growing. Poisonous.*
- ☐ **N. DOUBLE PINK** Heavy bloom clusters of large, double pink flowers.
 - ☐ **N. DOUBLE WHITE** Large double white flowers that offer a nice contrast to the pink if potted together.
 - ✿ **N. RED** Clusters of single red blooms, narrow leaves that are dark green and glossy.

OXALIS (Shamrock) *Mostly green leaved plants with shamrock leaf shapes. These can be multiplied by division. Low light and cool. Most need a rest period.*

- ☐ **O. REGNELLII** Clump forming with green leaves, topped by tiny light pink flowers in summer.
- ☐ **O. REGNELLII TRIANGULARIS** As above but with deep, velvety purple leaves.
- ☐ **O. DEPPEI** A bulb-forming four-leaf-clover from Mexico with red-pink flowers in summer.
- ☐ **OSCULARIA DELTOIDES** A succulent with thick toothed blue-grey leaves and pink daisy-like blooms.

- ☐ **ANTONIA** Double fantasy blooms with a green edge over plain green foliage.
- ☐ **APACHE ARROWPOINT**. Large, double lavender flowers with darker lavender edges. Green and bronze, crown-variegated foliage.
- ✿ **APACHE DIAMOND** Bright raspberry semi-double ruffled stars, over white, green, and pink leaves.
- ✿ **APACHE SHOWOFF** Hot pink semi-double pansies with red eyes over dark green and pink foliage.
- ☐ **APACHE SUNBURST** Large pansies with upper petals in burgundy and lower in pink. Dark green leaves edged with white and pink ruffles.
- ☐ **APPLAUSE** Semi-double lavender blooms shading to purple edge, over plain green foliage.
- ✿ **ARIA** Single to semi-double blue-purple stars with white edge over dark green, cream, and pink foliage.
- ☐ **BIG DADDY** Large semi-double blooms of bright purple, up to 3". Green foliage with red reverse.
- ☐ **BLUE DRAGON** Semi-double to double stars of pale blue with dark eye and red band, variable green edge. Dark green foliage.
- ☐ **BLUEBEARD** Semi-double blooms in blue over variegated foliage.
- ☐ **BLUSHING FANTASY** Pink semi-double and double stars splashed with deep blue fantasy, hot pink eye. Deep green foliage with red reverse..
- ☐ **BLUSHING IVORY** Single ivory stars blushed with wide bands of pink-orchid glitter. Dark green foliage.
- ☐ **BOB SERBIN** Semi-double red sticktite pansies with a thin white edge. Dark green, quilted leaves with serrated edges and red backs.
- ☐ **BOB'S OMEGA** Single pink blooms with a rose stripe frosting plain green foliage.
- ☐ **BRIGHT EYES** Single pale lavender two-tone blooms over variegated leaves.
- ✿ **CANADIAN MOONLIGHT** Single to semi-double pale purple pansies over frosted green and white foliage.
- ☐ **CANDY SWIRLS** Semi-double white and pink large pansies with pink eye and edge. Medium green leaves, quilted and scalloped.
- ☐ **CENTENNIAL THUNDER** Large white blooms with lavender-tinted ring and edges, green leaves.
- ☐ **CHARTREUSE WONDER** Semi-double to double white blooms graced with lacy chartreuse edges and brushed with light pink. Wavy light foliage.
- ☐ **COLONIAL PORT FAIRY** Semi-double to double blooms of light blue over medium green leaves.
- ☐ **COLONIAL TASMAN** Semi-double lavender flowers with blue fantasy. Dark green leaves.
- ☐ **CORAL MAGIC** Single to semi-double dark coral-red blossoms displayed over dark green leaves.
- ☐ **CORALLETTE** Double coral blooms with variable white edge. Light green, glossy, quilted leaves.
- ☐ **DELFT IMPERIAL** Double blue two-tone fringed

- blooms with variable white edge. Quilted leaves.
- ❑ **DESIGNER DRESS** Semi-double pink frilled stars with lighter shading, white edge. Dark green, heart-shaped, quilted, and wavy leaves.
 - ❑ **DIERDRE** Semi-double light red and light pink blooms over green leaves.
 - ✿ **EUREKA** Single to semi-double blue stars with lighter centers, rays, and edges. Tommie Lou green and pink foliage with red reverse.
 - ❑ **FESTIVE AMETHYST** Semi-double amethyst stars shaded with lavender, as well as streaks of dark purple. Deep green, quilted foliage.
 - ❑ **FESTIVE HOLIDAY** White semi-double pansies edged in red top leaves with mosaic variegation.
 - ✿ **FIREBRAND** Semi-double coral, red, and pink blooms blaze above medium green plain foliage.
 - ❑ **FIREWORKS**. Double red blooms over dark green, quilted leaves.
 - ❑ **GHOST DANCE** Large double white blooms, usually touched on the edges by a ghostly shade of green. Light quilted leaves of mid-green.
 - ❑ **GLITTER STAR** Large double pink stars with a ruby red glitter edge. Ivory and rose variegation on leaves.
 - ❑ **GOLDEN THREADS** Double and semi-double white stars shaded and brushed with tones of yellow. Medium green tailored foliage.
 - ❑ **GRAFFITI** Semi-double pink stars streaked with a blue stripe. Symmetrical, medium-green foliage.
 - ✿ **GRAND MASTER** Single purple sticktite stars with raspberry edges above medium green foliage.
 - ❑ **HAWAIIAN PEARL** Semi-double and double stars of ivory, banded in a wide halo of deep lavender rose. Deep green leaves.
 - ❑ **HIS PROMISE** Grow under lower light to bring out the varying soft yellow tones on glistening double white blossoms. Bright green, tailored foliage.
 - ❑ **HOT SPOT** Large ruby red semi-double stars. Wavy foliage shapes into a compact show plant.
 - ❑ **IMPOSTER** Double plum-wine stars with white edge. Dark green and cream, glossy leaves.
 - ✿ **IRISH MAIDEN** Double green flowers touched with white and pink, over medium green ruffled foliage.
 - ❑ **ISLAND CORAL** Double coral pansies with white edge. Medium green, plain, pointed leaves.
 - ✿ **JONATHAN** Semi-double lavender blooms with darker top petals float above dark green foliage.
 - ❑ **JUNE ROSE** A unique tri-color double. Red with orchid and a heavy edge of white. Dark green foliage.
 - ❑ **KIMONO** Semi-double burgundy pansies with pink fantasy. Medium green leaves.
 - ❑ **LADY BIRD** A large brilliant double red. Dark green quilted foliage. Outstandingly beautiful.
 - ❑ **LAMBERT CLOSE** Semi-double lavender red stars. Dark green and cream variegated foliage.

- ❑ **FITTONIA ARGYRONEURA NANA** (Silver nerve plant) Attractive foliage plant with ovate leaves netted in silver veins. Small-growing.
 - ❑ **FUCHSIA TRIPHYLLA GARTENMEISTER BONSTEDT** A reliable winter blooming Fuchsia. Bright orange-red flowers. Dark bronzy leaves.
 - ✿ **FUCHSIA Assorted** Named varieties with a range of bloom types and foliage. Hardy in mild areas.
- HEBE (New Zealand boxwood)**
These small evergreen shrubs have neatly arranged leaves in a variety of shades and shapes and usually feature small flowering spikes. Sun or part shade, cool growing, hardy outside in mild areas.
- ✿ **H. ANOMALA** Slender upright red-purple stems with small dark green leaves. The flowers are white.
 - ✿ **H. AUTUMN GLORY** New leaves purple, maturing to green. Purple flowers.

 - ❑ **HEBE WAIREKA** Larger rounded leaves of gold and green and a more open habit than other varieties. Deep purple flowers in summer.
- HEDERA HELIX (Ivy)** *English Ivy provides a vast array of different leaf shapes and patterns. Prefers to be cool.*
- ❑ **H. DUCKFOOT** forms tiny mounds of miniature leaves shaped like duck feet.
 - ❑ **H. GLACIER** Leaves of green and white. Compact rather slow grower but worth the wait.
 - ❑ **H. GOLD CHILD** Grey-green centers with golden margins, five-lobed leaves.
 - ✿ **H. GOLD DUST** Medium green leaves diffused with creamy yellow variegation.
 - ✿ **H. GOLD HEART** Dark green leaves with a central splash of gold.
 - ❑ **H. HAHNS SELF BRANCHING** An all green ivy that spreads rapidly.
 - ❑ **H. IVALACE** (Lacy Leaf Ivy) Small, closely held frilly leaves of crinkled dark green.
 - ❑ **H. KOLIBRI** Silver-white flecked with emerald.
 - ✿ **H. OAK LEAF** Miniature oak-shaped leaves.
 - ❑ **H. PETITE POINT** Deeply divided green leaves with very sharp points.
 - ✿ **H. RITTERKREUZ** Leaves shaped like Knight's Cross, dark green with five pointed lobes.
 - ❑ **H. SCUTIFOLIA** An interesting ivy of perfect heart-shaped leaves.
- HIBISCUS (Rose of China)** *These plants can be grown indoors or as patio plants. If you want to keep them small and well shaped prune after flowering. Keep moist at all times and give good light.*
- ❑ **ASSORTED** A mixture of large blooming types. Colors vary from yellow to pink, red, and two-toned.

- HOYA (Wax Plant)** *Hoyas are mostly vining and make great houseplants in pots and baskets. They can be trained to climb. Keep in bright light, do not overwater.*

 - ❑ **H. LACUNOSA** Small glossy leaves, tiny ruffled white flowers. *Limited quantities.*
 - ❑ **H. LONGIFOLIA** Pencil thin leaves and blooms of starry white. *Limited quantities.*
 - ✿ **H. NICHOLSONIAE** Clusters of yellow star shaped flowers with white centers, strongly veined leaves. *Limited quantities.*
 - ❑ **H. OBSCURA** Deep rose-pink glossy leaves with light green veins. Clusters of salmon pink flowers. Small, compact growing. *Limited quantities.*
 - ✿ **H. PUBICALYX RED BUTTONS** A fast growing hoya with bunches of scented mauve-red flowers.
 - ❑ **H. SERPENS** Miniature trailer with dark green, dime sized leaves. Large clusters of fragrant pink flowers. *Limited quantities.*
 - ❑ **H. TSANGII** Small dusky rose oval leaves with maroon edges. Clusters of red flowers tipped with yellow. Compact grower with trailing stems. *Limited quantities.*
- ❑ **HYLOCEREUS UNDATUS** (Red Dragon Fruit). A night blooming cactus like *Epiphyllum*, with trailing stems, large fragrant blooms, large edible red fruit.

 - ✿ **IREFINE HERBSTII** Blood Leaf produces bright red leaves given bright light and moisture.

- ❑ **E. BELLA VISTA** Flared bell blooms in raspberry purple with pink sepals. Early bloomer.
- ❑ **E. BOB GRIMSHAW** Multi-petaled flower of deep scarlet. Inner petals have wide ring of hot fuchsia.
- ❑ **E. DESERT SUNRISE** Glowing orange-lavender inner petals, outer petals red. Opens wide.
- ❑ **E. EMPRESS** Shades of pink and coral, cup and saucer bloom shape.
- ❑ **E. EUPHROSINE** Blooms of double pink in about the mid-season. A good reliable bloomer.
- ❑ **E. FLORENCE REED ARNOLD** Extra large double with coral pink petals and brick red throat.
- ❑ **E. GEORGE WOODARD** Orange red with plum throat. Slightly ruffled blooms.
- ❑ **E. GNARLY GOLD** A perfectly round shape of multi-petaled yellow, dark in the back ranging to lighter shades on the front. Very vigorous.
- ❑ **E. HEAVEN SENT** Unique combination of lavender edged in ruffled white. Outer petals are red and orange.
- ❑ **E. IVORY BROCADE** Satin white inner petals with ruffled edges. Outer petals deep yellow, edged in bronze.
- ❑ **E. JENNIFER ANN** -Well shaped yellow blooms with long, spiky outer petals and cupped inner petals in graduated lengths.
- ❑ **E. MAIDU** Overlapping petals of deep Indian orange, wrapped around a bright magenta throat. Loose cup.
- ❑ **E. MARIE JOSEPHINE** Giant creamy yellow blooms, opening huge and lasting long.
- ❑ **E. ORANGE CRUSH** Wide open bell-shaped bloom in golden orange, with darker orange midstripe and edges. Greenish throat. Good, pendulant growth.
- ❑ **E. OXYPETALUM** (Night Blooming Epiphyllum) Where modern hybrids come from. Beautiful white cup-shaped blooms in a "Dutchman's Pipe" shape.
- ❑ **E. PAINTED DESERT** Soft sunset colors of very light orange with a raspberry throat. Several rows of petals, shorter in front.
- ❑ **E. RED SAILS** Bright scarlet red inner petals deepening to bright red outer petals. Opens wide.
- ❑ **E. REWARD** Silky wide-open blooms in multi shades of yellow. Inner petals yellow brushed in cream. Vigorous growth habit.
- ❑ **E. ROSE OF LANCASTER** Stunning tomato red satiny petals with rounded edges. Wide open.
- ❑ **E. SAKURAHIME** Large blooms in shades of cherry blossom pink.
- ❑ **E. SHAWNA** Compact flower with petals of pure, sparkling white. Outer petals are solid lavender.
- ❑ **E. SIEGFRIED** Exquisite pastel pink inner petals are framed by rose yellow sepals. Easy to grow, vigorous.

- ❑ **COFFEA ARABICA** (Coffee Plant) Grow your own coffee! Dwarf tree with shiny dark green foliage. Grows to about 18" in the house.

- ❑ **CRASSULA OVATA Tricolor** (Tricolor Jade) Thick fleshy leaves in green white and pink. Easy, tough.

- ❑ **DATURA** (Devil's Trumpet) **\$5.00** These shrubby short-lived perennials are related to Brugmansia but have flowers that point up rather than hang down. We will have **limited** numbers of a few varieties.
- EPIPHYLLUM (Orchid Cactus) \$5.00**
Give them lots of light, but no full summer sun and they will reward you with flowers to 8" in a rainbow of colors. Keep them just moist. They can be grown in pots, hanging baskets or even patio stands.
- ✿ **E. ACKERMANII** The parent species of the many hybrid dav-flowerina varieties. Bright red blooms.

- ❑ **A. MEGAPOTAMICUM KENTISH BELLE** Narrow leaves and dangling yellow flowers with red calyces.
 - ✿ **A. MEGAPOTAMICUM VARIEGATUM** Blooms like Kentish Belle, larger leaves with yellow spots.
 - ❑ **A. MARIGOLD BELLE** Orange red with red veins.
 - ✿ **A. ROSEUS** Soft pink blooms with darker veins.
 - ❑ **A. SOUVENIR DE BONN** Variegated leaves in bright green with broad white edges.
 - ❑ **A. VESUVIUS RED** Drooping bells in rich red.
 - ❑ **ACALYPHA HISPIDA** (Chenille plant) Fuzzy red cat-tails over small green leaves, nice in hanging baskets.
- ACHIMENES** (Cupid's Bower) *Rhizomatous plants loaded with colorful blooms over small leaves. Great for hanging baskets. They go dormant for the winter.*
- ✿ **A. PURPLE KING** Large purple blooms.
 - ✿ **A. PARK'S MIX** Assorted pinks and purples.
 - ❑ **AESCHYNANTHUS** (Lipstick Plant)
Showy hanging basket plants. Do best in a warm location and if allowed to dry out between waterings.
 - ❑ **A. BLACK PAGODA** Dark green leaves netted in burgundy, yellow-orange red-tipped bloom.
 - ❑ **A. LOBBIANUS** Fiery red blooms with creamy throat. Dark green leaves.
 - ✿ **A. LONGICAULIS** Bold zebra striped leaves, green flowers. Grown mainly for foliage.
 - ✿ **A. MICRANTHUS** Compact trailer with small thick green leaves and dark red blooms.
 - ❑ **A. MONA LISA** Dark green leaves, deep scarlet blooms in darker calyces.
 - ❑ **A. PURPLE STAR** Large-red flowers, upright growth.
 - ❑ **A. RUBENS** Light green leaves and upright clusters of yellow-orange tubular blooms.
 - ✿ **ALBIZIA JULIBRISSIN** (Mimosa) Shrub with lacy foliage and pink powderpuff flowers. Takes some frost
 - ❑ **ALLAMANDA CATHARTICA** (Golden Trumpet) A climbing or bush plant with large yellow blooms.
 - ❑ **ALOE CHINENIS** (Medicine Aloe) A smaller growing version of the famous Aloe Vera.
 - ❑ **ALSOBIA DIANTHIFLORA** Large deeply fringed white flowers. Small dark green downy leaves in tiny rosettes. Stoloniiferous, trailing.
 - ✿ **ALYOGYNE HUEGELII** (Blue Hibiscus) Evergreen shrub with lilac blue blooms and lobed leaves.
 - ❑ **ARISTOLOCHIA MACROPHYLLA** (Dutchman's Pipe) A vigorous vine with large heart-shaped leaves and unusual pipe-shaped blooms.
 - ❑ **A. ELEGANS** (Calico Flower) Flowering vine from Brazil. Yellow throated blooms marked in purple brown and white.
 - ❑ **ASPIDISTRA ELATIOR** (Cast Iron Plant) An old favorite with long green leaves, easy care.
 - ✿ **A. ELIATOR MILKY WAY** As above, but with clusters of white spots like night sky.
 - ✿ **A. ELIATOR VARIEGATA** Broad creamv stripes.

BEGONIA

A diverse group of plants that grow best in shaded but bright locations. They enjoy lots of humidity.

- ✿ **B. BENITOCHIBA** Palmate leaves in metallic rose-red. Self-branching and shrubby. Pink flowers.
- ❑ **B. BOWERI** Foliage plant with bristly pointed leaves netted with brown.
- ❑ **B. CHRISTMAS CANDY** A vigorous cross of *Semperflorens* x Argentine species. Double red blooms over Christmas. Green leaves.
- ❑ **B. COSIE** One of the best white Angel Wing Begonias. Pearl colored blooms. Long slender dark foliage. Winter blooming.
- ✿ **B. CRASSICAULIS** Stout upright stems hold large sharp lobed deciduous leaves; sprays of tiny flowers appear in late winter.
- ❑ **B. ERYTHROPHYLLA** Beefsteak begonia – large round leaves with blood red backs, white flowers.
- ❑ **B. FUCHSIOIDES** A shrubby begonia with small oval leaves and coral red flowers in numerous short sprays. Grows to 3 ft (1 m) tall with graceful drooping branchlets. Prefers good light.
- ❑ **B. HOT TAMALE** Long dark fluted leaves with maroon undersides. Showers of pink-red blooms.
- ❑ **B. LUCY LOCKET** Vigorous plant with robust light bronze leaves and double balls of pink flowers.
- ✿ **B. OROCOCO** Coppery green-gold leaves, slightly pebbled, edged in rust, on trailing stems.
- ❑ **B. RICHMONDENSIS** Arching 12–15" stems with glossy dark green foliage bear pendant clusters of pink blooms.
- ✿ **B. SCHARFFII** Fleshy upright stems bear large, hairy pointed olive leaves with red backs. White flowers.

BOUGAINVILLEA (Paper Flower)

These plants require lots of light. They are ideal for the greenhouse or patio/sunroom. Compact types can be grown in 4" pots. All look great in hanging baskets, but are best planted in groups of 3 in large baskets. Prune back when finished blooming and re-pot or add fertilizer.

- ❑ **B. BARBARA KARST** Brilliant red blooms on an upright or basket plant. The standard red variety, even more red in strong sun.
- ✿ **B. XBUTTIANA** Hybrid of *glabra* x *peruviana*. Shrubby with pink to red bracts.
- ❑ **B. CALIFORNIA GOLD** Golden yellow blooms. Prolific bloomer in either a pot or hanging basket.
- ❑ **B. DOUBLE GOLD** Compact growing. Bushy ever blooming double golden orange bracts.
- ❑ **B. DOUBLE RED** Double bracts of crimson red. Compact grower.
- ❑ **B. DOUBLE WHITE** Similar growth habit to the above plants but the bracts are double white.
- ❑ **B. GLABRA** Slightly smaller growing, more flexible branches. Pinkish purple bracts.

- ❑ **VAMPIRE'S KISS** Semi-double and double blood red stars, shaded in almost black. Lightly quilted foliage. Extremely good bloomer.
- ❑ **VICTORIAN ELEGANCE** Dark red-mauve semi-double stars, with a wide pale pink ruffled edge. Deep green foliage with red reverse.
- ❑ **WHAM BANG** Double cerise-red fluted blooms. Dark green, glossy, ruffled foliage.
- ❑ **WILLODENE** Semi-double blooms of peach pink with deeper eyes and darker edging. Shaded green, white and pink variegated foliage.
- ❑ **WRANGLER'S SNOWFIELDS** Semi-double stars of snowy white over bronzy dark green foliage.
- ❑ **ZAPPED** Double coral blooms with pink and purple fantasy, dark green red-backed leaves.

MINI & SEMI-MINIATURE Leaf \$1.25, Plant \$3.50

If space is a problem or you enjoy masses of bloom on small plants, try these. Keep in small pots (2 or 3"). Growing conditions are the same as for Standards.

- ❑ **BABY BLUE JEANS** Single and semi-double pansies in medium blue, medium green foliage. Semi-mini.
- ❑ **BALLET BLUE ICE** Masses of double blue flowers over medium green semi-miniature foliage.
- ❑ **BLUE SILHOUETTE** Semi-double light blue two-tone pansies with variable white and green. Black-green leaves with red back. Semi-mini.
- ❑ **BOO MAN** Semi-double to double light blue frilled pansy with white-feathered top petals, variable green. Black-green leaves. Semi-mini.
- ✿ **BRIDAL LADY** Single to semi-double white sticktite ruffled bells over green and cream girl foliage.
- ❑ **CRUSHED VELVET** Semi-double frilled blooms in deep burgundy, over dark green foliage. Semi-mini.
- ✿ **DEAN'S KITTEN** Single pink blooms with orchid eyes over dark green red-backed leaves. Semi-mini.
- ❑ **FROSTY FUN** Double white large blooms over variegated green and white foliage. Semi-mini.
- ❑ **GEISHA GIRL** Semi-mini in peach two-tones with upper petals in a deeper peach. A prolific bloomer with dark green, pointed foliage that shapes well.
- ❑ **GOLDEN DAWN** White with rays of yellow and fuchsia on variegated white foliage. Semi-mini.
- ❑ **HONEY BLUE ANGEL** Semi-double dark blue blooms with white edge. Mini green girl foliage.
- ❑ **HUTZLER'S BABY** Single pink and purple fantasy. Medium green leaves. Semi-mini.
- ✿ **LEMON COOKIE** Semi-double to double creamy white blooms with yellow centers over medium green and white leaves. Semi-mini.

- ✿ **LEMON DROP** Double white pansies splashed and rayed with yellow, Semi-mini with tailored foliage.
- ✿ **LEONE** Double white stars with red edge over pointed, quilted, and ruffled leaves. Semi-mini.
- ☐ **LITTLE BRITCHES** Fully double pink fantasy with tiny blue dots and dashes on all the petals. Medium green semi-miniature foliage.
- ✿ **LITTLE PRO** Semi-double pink blooms over dark green quilted leaves with red reverse. Semi-mini.
- ✿ **LOVEY DOVE** Semi-double white pansies edged in pink, yellow accents. Variegated leaves. Semi-mini.
- ☐ **MIDNIGHT RASCAL** Semi-double medium blue pansies with raspberry frilled edge. Medium green, ovate, red backed leaves. Semi-mini.
- ☐ **MOTLEY CREW** Semi-double pink stars with a hint of mauve and variable white markings. Olive green semi-miniature foliage.
- ✿ **NESS' BLUE SQUIRT** Double medium blue blooms over dark green leaves. Semi-mini.

- ☐ **HOT PINK BELLS** Single pink bells over medium green semi-mini foliage.
- ☐ **LAMBS' EARS** Double cream-white blooms with bright pink edge. Bright green leaves. Standard.
- ☐ **MAGIC FOUNTAIN** Pink single to semi-double stars over crown variegated standard foliage.
- ☐ **MILKY WAY TRAIL** A sky full of dainty white single and double pansies. Semi miniature.
- ✿ **MINT PINK** Double light pink stars with mint green edging and petal tips. Semi-mini.
- ☐ **NATALIA'S CANDIED POPCORN** Double white with pink blush. Dark green leaves. Semi-mini.
- ☐ **NYAKA TRAIL** Single dark blue blooms with darker centers over dark green semi-mini leaves.
- ☐ **PACIFIC PEARL** Double white/blue multicolor. Variegated wavy, pointed foliage. Miniature.

TROPICAL AND FOLIAGE HOUSEPLANTS

Except where noted, these plants need normal house temperatures, as much light as possible without full sun (except in winter) and as high a humidity as can be maintained. Use a little fertilizer every week and prune to keep in shape. Price \$4.00 unless otherwise noted. Cuttings may be available for \$2 – please inquire first.
ABUTILON (Flowering Maple) Known to the Victorians as Flowering Maples, these bushy plants with maple-like foliage and bell flowers make excellent houseplants. They bloom most of the year and are not bothered by the odd cool period. Fertilize regularly and keep moist.
